Introduction



The purpose of this little book. The purpose of this little book is to increase joy in your daily life, by giving you words to sing with the gladness of heart that comes from a consecrated life. The words on these pages express biblical truths written to be sung to the melodies of beloved Christmas carols.

Why new words for old hymns? One autumn afternoon about a year ago, when I was pondering Isaiah 41:10, the phrase "Look! The Lord my God is near" floated up in my mind to the melody of "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing." As I wrote those words, more followed. Friends liked the "new" words and thought, as I did, that they would help keep the Word of God in mind during daily life. I desperately needed that! I was learning that keeping my mind filled with and focused on God's truth kept my heart at peace and empowered me to live free of depression and anxiety.

Over the next year, I grew more healed and more whole as I saw, hour by hour, day by day, the Word replacing dark thoughts and feelings and self-absorption with God's light and life and concern for others. I kept writing poetry, whenever God gently put phrases in my thoughts, and I planned, tentatively, to write a booklet of new words for Christmas carols.

For months, I faithfully labored to re-establish the regular writing habit depression had stolen. I also labored to establish habits of mind and heart that--I have learned to my unspeakable delight--keep my heart close to my beloved Jesus, free of depression and fear.

Gradually, writing became more regular, with poems dropping onto the page more often. Suddenly, it was November. I asked God to help me write twelve or so carols by Thanksgiving, so I could put the booklet on my blog (www.wordsofhopeandhealing.com) in time for Christmas.

For the next two weeks, God graciously gave a carol a day, sometimes two. I began the day by singing one carol, over and over, while getting dressed, driving the car, standing in line at the grocery, or waiting to pick up my grandsons.

As I sang the beloved old carols, I jotted the new words that came to mind on grocery lists, the back of the pages of Bible verses I memorize, and receipts in the glove box of the car.

Come when the small Rarely, it seemed, did the words notepad I carried was available.

Sometimes all the verses of a song were finished while I was out and about, doing daily life. Other times, I got part of some verses and then got stuck. When the flow of metrical words faltered, I found that searching the Word always supplied truth that finished the verse and so often started another.

At the same time God was pouring out the poetry He also poured out even deeper grace to keep myself calm. What a priceless, gracious gift from the One who loves each of us so! I pray these words help you also receive greater strength to abide in the peace that comes from awareness of His presence.

Why new words for Christmas carols? Music aids memory, and we all need more of God's Word hidden in our hearts. One reason we remember words of songs is that words embedded in music are more easily recalled. Once we learn the melody of a song, it is easy to learn new verses.

Many of us learn the most often-heard Christmas carols in childhood, and so these melodies are already imprinted in our hearts. Along with the melodies, the biblical truth contained in the verses of Christmas carols is also imprinted in our hearts.

As we sing these recast verses, I pray that Holy Spirit grafts these additional biblical truths into the melodies already in our hearts and that these Biblical seeds bear much fruit in our lives.

In this season of giving, may His love be our reason for living.

- [4] I know not what my future holds in life's amazing race, but I will live with Him one day and see Him face to face.


 One day when all earth's torments cease, when life on earth is through, I'll reign with Jesus up above, in power and in truth.




